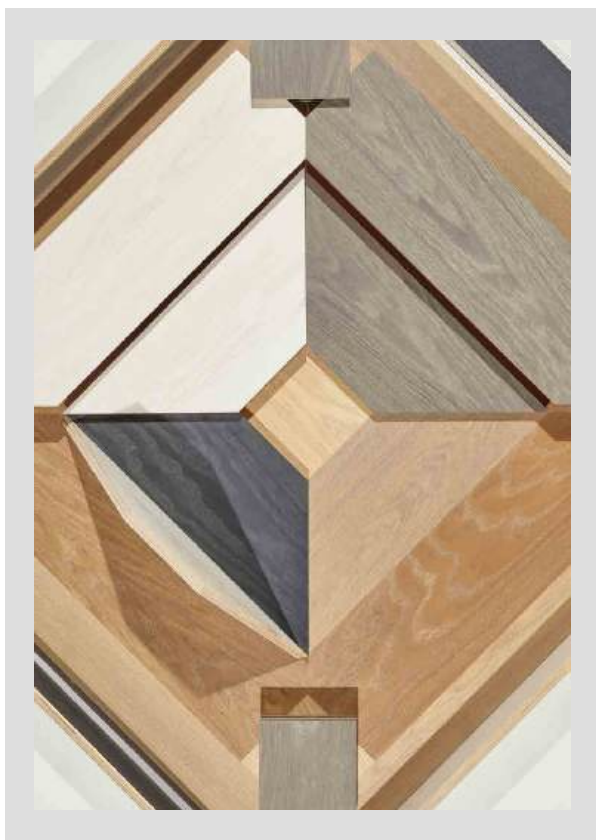

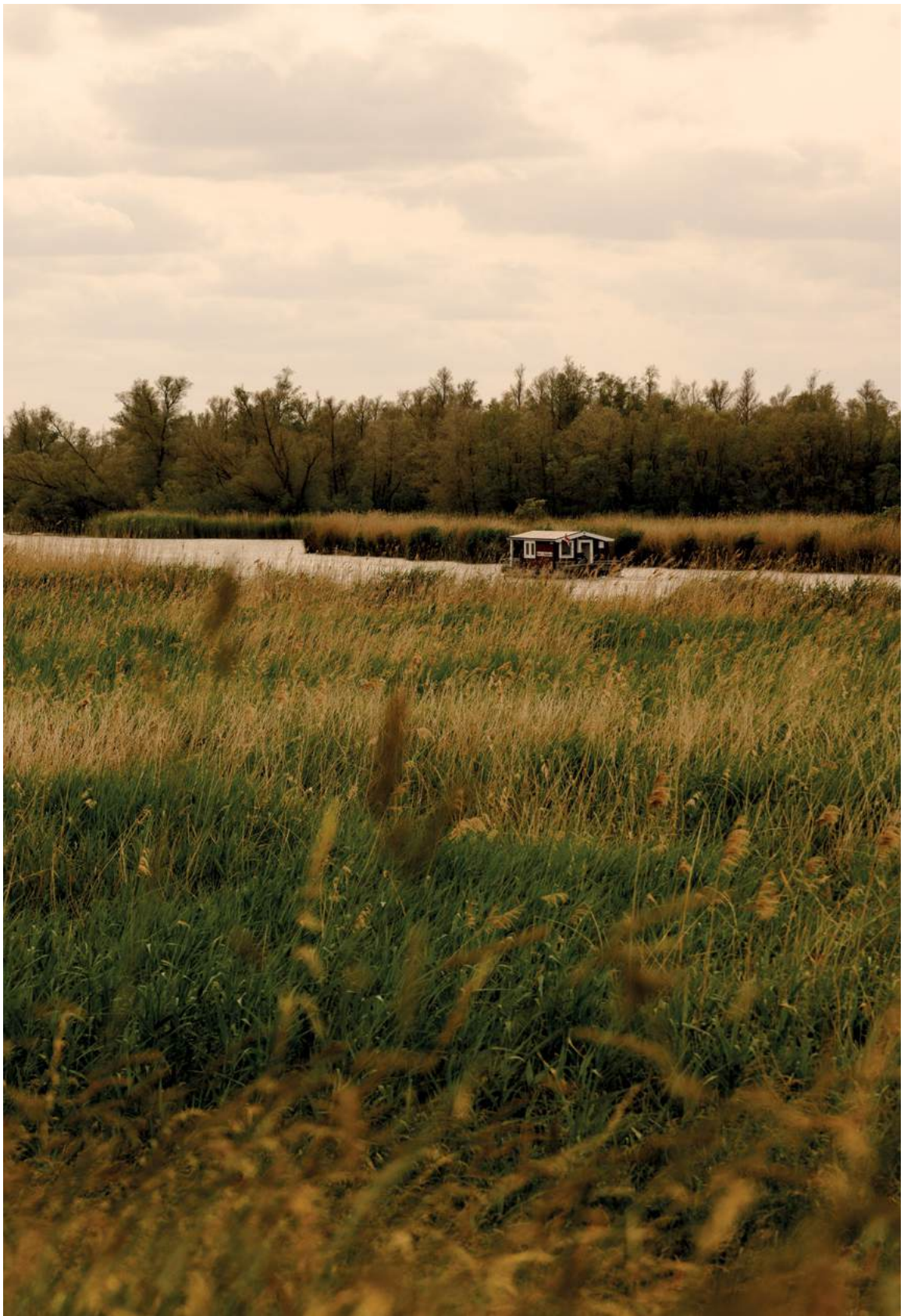

The Legacy of Hakwood





Hakwood's creations are deeply rooted in Dutch culture and the country's urban and natural landscapes. The historic heart of the small town of Gorinchem, just a few kilometers from the factory, inspires a sense of perpetuity. Along its canals, past and present intertwine in a beauty defined by simplicity and harmony. For over 45 years, the company has shared its story with a family that is firmly anchored in its region and dedicated to an ideal of authentic craftsmanship.







Nestled on the edge of Biesbosch National Park, where trees, water, and lush vegetation shape a truly inspiring landscape, the Hakwood factory is set in an exceptional environment that mirrors the company's values and deep connection to nature.

When Mark Hak reflects on his life, he considers not only his own story, but also that of the family business – two narratives that are inextricably linked. Now at the helm of the company, which he runs with his cousin Robert Hak, Mark has transformed Hakwood into an internationally recognized premium brand, setting new standards of excellence in its field.

Although Hakwood had always been part of his surroundings, it was in 1992 that Mark Hak officially joined the company, working in production management. At that time, Hakwood specialized exclusively in wall coverings for the DIY market, which it exported worldwide. In the early 2000s, shortly before his cousin joined the company, Mark initiated Hakwood's move into parquet flooring, managing international distribution. Robert Hak joined the business soon thereafter, further strengthening the family's involvement. Initially focusing on local and regional markets, Hakwood soon expanded its area of activity across Europe and the United Kingdom, before growing its team and forging global partnerships in countries such as South Africa, Brazil, and the United States.

Today, while he continues to oversee international development and sales, Mark is also responsible for sourcing the finest raw materials – primarily oak and ash from Germany and Eastern Europe. When he describes himself as “down to earth,” the expression reveals more than a pragmatic mindset; it reflects his genuine connection to the land – he is grounded, sincere, and deeply attuned to nature. Passionate about the great outdoors, he lives with his family on a farm where he breeds livestock. For rare moments of relaxation, he escapes to Norway to fish in the wild. Even at work, nature is ever-present: bordering the Hakwood factory lies the Biesbosch National Park, a vast, untamed landscape of rivers winding through a freshwater delta. This preserved ecosystem, rich in flora and fauna, offers a constant source of inspiration.

This setting nourishes Mark's philosophy and thinking about the authenticity of the products he offers – natural wood boards and tiles whose beauty and durability lie in the nobility and faultless quality of the oak and ash species used.





OAK AND ASH

For centuries, oak and ash have been used in projects required to stand the test of time: architecture, shipbuilding and furniture. In the pursuit of excellence and in order to supply high-quality wood with optimum stability, Hakwood sources the finest varieties of these naturally sustainable native species from European woodlands from France to the Balkans.

Founded in the Netherlands in 1979, Hakwood has established itself as a leading name in the world of high-end wood flooring. The family-run company, currently led by cousins Mark and Robert Hak, has evolved over time and across the directorship of three generations to become a global leader in its field.

When Robert Hak joined the family business in early 2002, he was continuing a story that had been part of his life since childhood. He grew up spending much of his time following his father around the Hakwood factory, absorbing the rhythms of a company where craftsmanship and wood were at the heart of everything.

Armed with a background in mechanics and professional experience in the timber industry, Robert entered the company with a clear ambition: to bring it into the 21st century. At that time, the factory still relied on traditional machinery and methods. Robert took it upon himself to modernize every process, introducing digital systems and upgrading the entire production infrastructure. His goal was simple yet ambitious – to ensure that Hakwood could meet the growing demands of a rapidly expanding international market.

Over the years, his efforts have transformed the company from the inside out. Today, supported by a dedicated team, Robert is responsible for production, planning and IT. Under his guidance, Hakwood has become synonymous with high-quality natural wood flooring and parquet tiles that combine environmental responsibility with exceptional craftsmanship – a source of pride for a man deeply attached to values of authenticity and excellence.

True to his nature, Robert has remained grounded – quite literally. He lives just a few kilometers from the factory with his wife and four children, on a farm where he breeds cattle and pigs. When time allows, he trades the workshop for the open water on his motorboat, another expression of the freedom and balance that define both the man and his work.

This meticulous approach reflects Hakwood's exacting standards and desire to showcase the luxurious simplicity of wood.

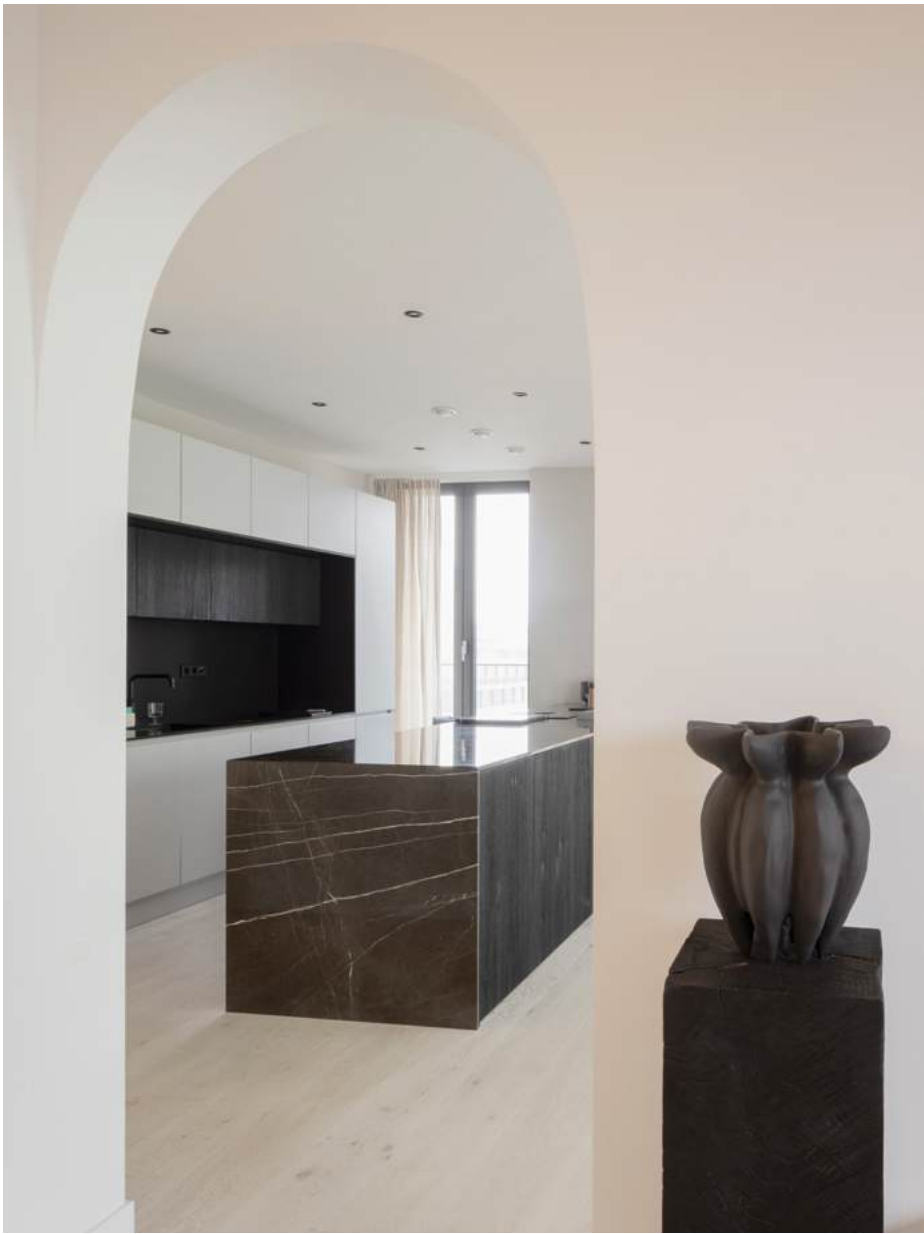

CORDILLERA LAKE HOUSE

COEUR D'ALENE, IDAHO

RESIDENTIAL PROJECT



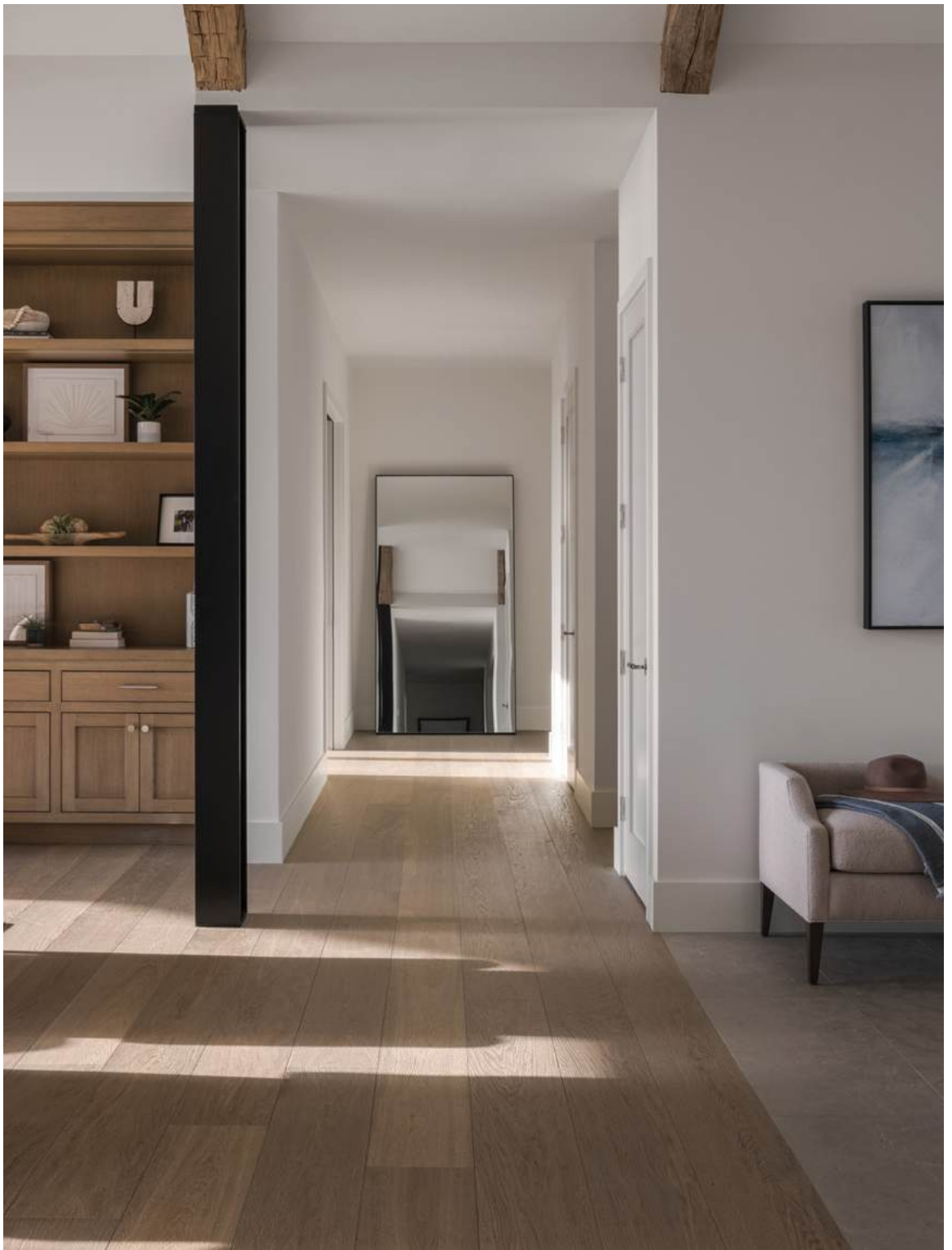
Designed by James Davis Custom Homes, this house offers sweeping views over the magnificent landscape of the lakeside resort of Coeur d'Alene in the Rocky Mountains.

Embracing its exceptional surroundings, the house gives breathtaking views over the lake, woods and nearby mountains. Its luxurious interiors draw on high-quality materials for a design that combines sleek spaces with absolute comfort. In echo of the surrounding landscape, the different volumes of the house use the natural tones of wood combined with a palette of soft, neutral colors: deep blue, browns and tones of light beige contribute to the luxurious yet understated feel of the interiors.

The architects selected Hakwood's Vista engineered wood flooring 240mm (9½") planks of a mid-tone brushed European oak. The warm tones are effectively brought to life by the luminosity of the different rooms and the harmonious contrast of the white walls.



Combined with the soft tones of the walls and the simple elegance of the furniture, this Vista finish creates an atmosphere of gentle harmony and provides a sense of depth.



The skimming light brings out the full richness of the European oak. Vista flooring, Premier 1-bis grade to highlight the grain, while DuoVarnish finish to capture the light and express the natural tones.

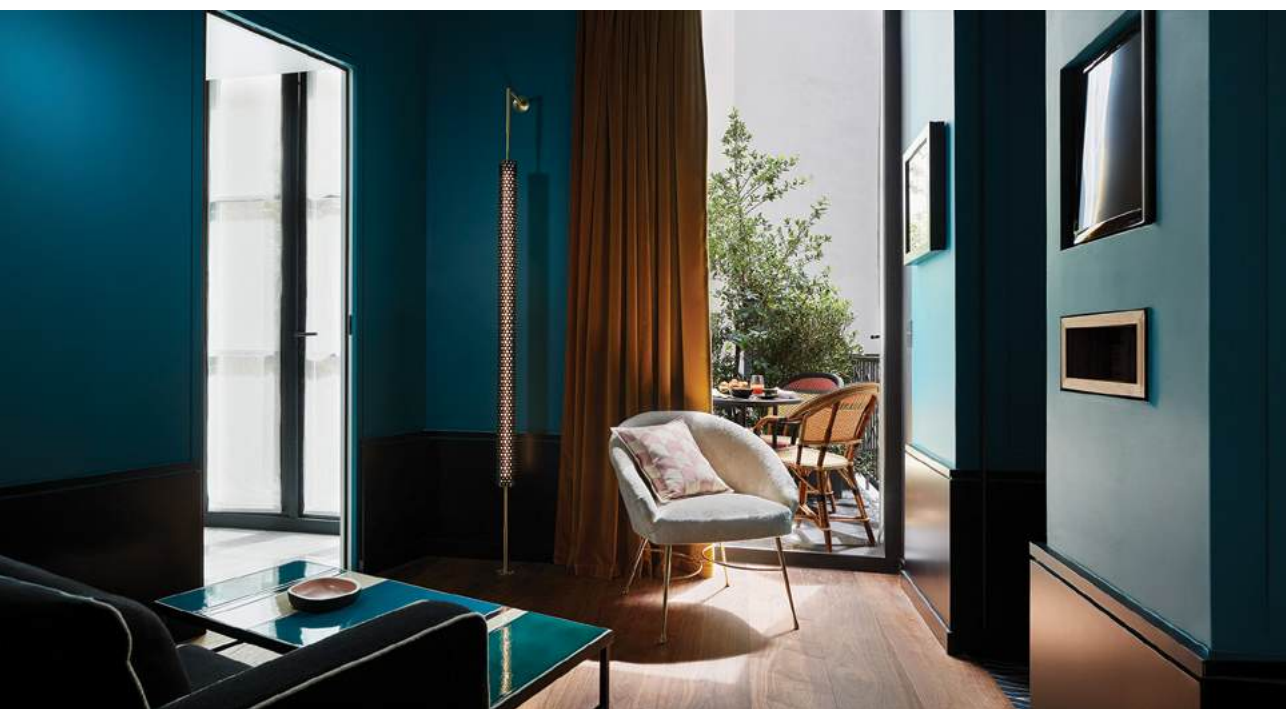

HOSPITALITY PROJECT

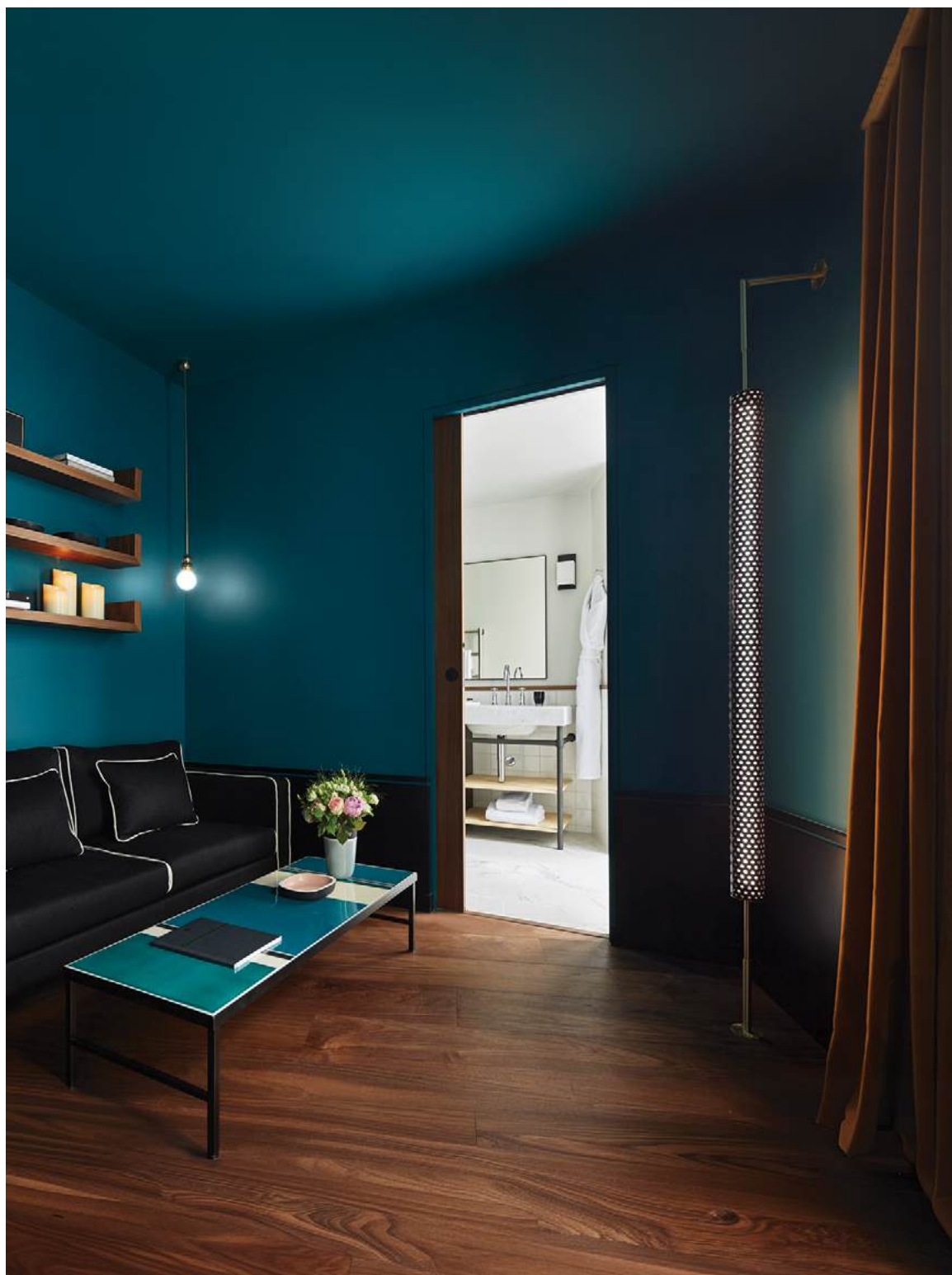


In a quiet street in the center of Paris, tucked away between the Louvre, the Palais Royal, the Opera and the Tuileries Gardens, Le Roch is a 5-star hotel designed by Studio Sarah Lavoine in the spirit of a townhouse.

Housed in a building typical of this part of Paris, interior designer and decorator Sarah Lavoine has designed the 37-room Le Roch Hotel & Spa as a secluded getaway in a style that is both urban and timeless. The different spaces of the hotel reflect the elegant and unostentatious decorative style that characterizes the designer's work. She has used a palette of deep, bright colors, natural materials, and sleek design that revisits French classicism.

In a contemporary take on luxury hospitality, interior designer Sarah Lavoine combines apparent simplicity with a host of sophisticated details, among which features bespoke wood flooring from Hakwood for bedrooms, commissioned by the designer. Using dark, natural oiled wood 240mm (9½") wide planks, the rich tones of the flooring create an atmosphere that is both cozy and luxurious.

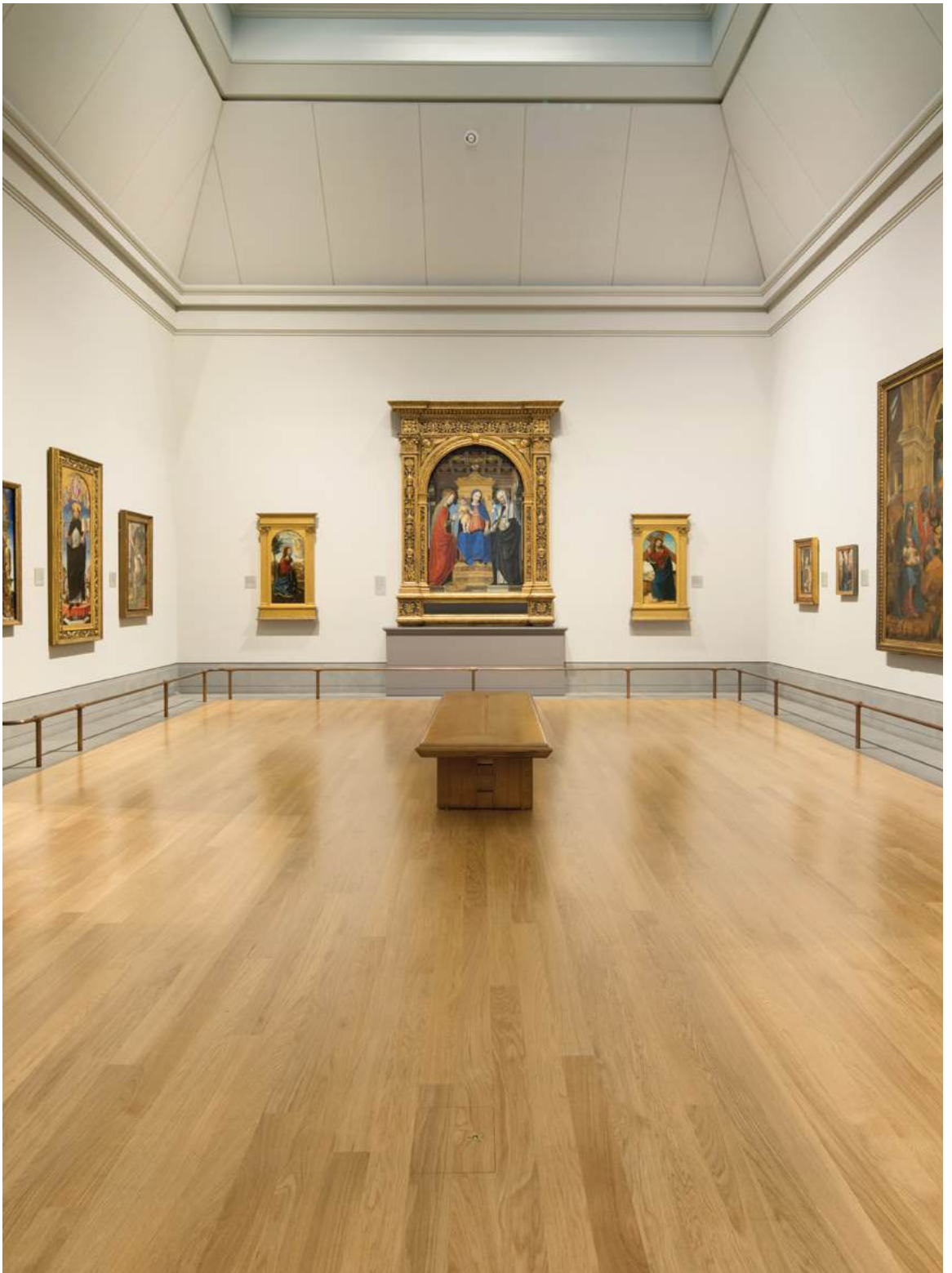
MUSEUM PROJECT



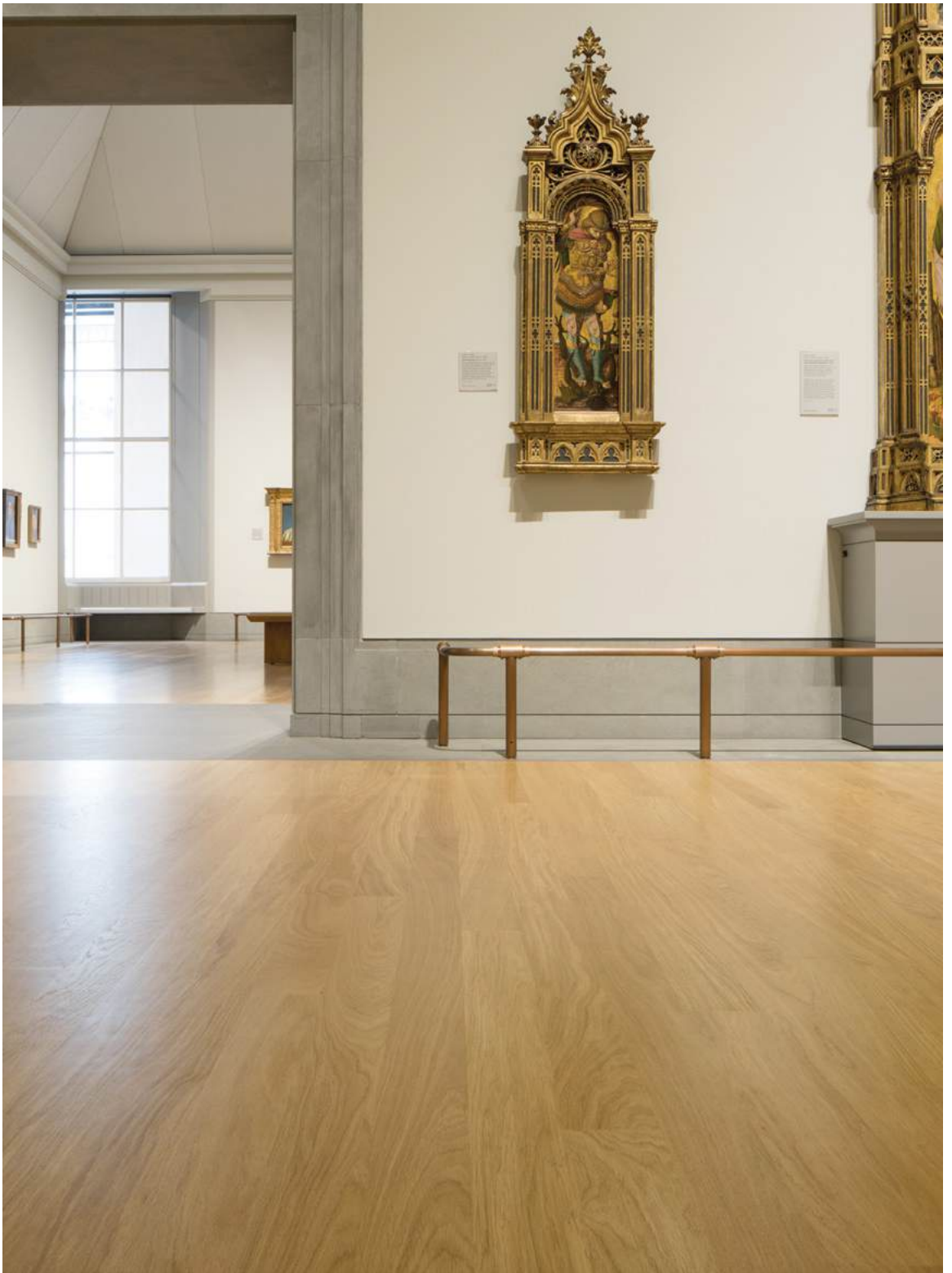
With a collection of over 2600 works, London's National Gallery is one of the largest and most prestigious museums in the world. An iconic institution in British cultural life, the Gallery welcomes large numbers of visitors every year.

The five galleries devoted to Italian and French paintings from the 15th to 17th centuries, located off the main hall of William Wilkins's Neoclassical building, had not been touched since the 1970s and were in need of modernization. The project, completed in 2009, was entrusted to architects Wright & Wright in close collaboration with the museum director.

Working to enhance the spaces with sensitivity, their project included new lighting and flooring for the galleries. They wanted elegant, neutral-colored flooring in natural materials. Hakwood's engineered European Oak hardwood flooring in the finish aptly named Original was chosen in 110 mm (4 11/32") wide planks to pair with the charcoal grey granite wall base to meet the vision and requirements for the museum's heavy footfall. The refurbishment achieved a fresh yet timeless quality appropriate to such an esteemed institution.

CASA IG SÃO PAULO, BRAZIL

RESIDENTIAL PROJECT



Part of a condominium complex, this stunning townhouse embraces the lush greenery that surrounds it, blurring the line between inside and outside spaces and creating a dialog between natural materials, primarily granite and wood.

Designed by prestigious architectural studio Arthur Casas, the home was designed for a couple with young children.

Focusing on creating a lively, welcoming environment and attentive to the sensations evoked by different materials, the architect has selected a harmony of tones running throughout seamless spaces. A light granite was chosen for the floor of the living spaces, with the walls and ceilings lined in Hakwood's Worthy Brushed 180mm (7 ") planks of classical-grade oiled European oak. Worthy Brushed was also used for the bedroom flooring, as well as for cupboards and alcoves, exploring every possible use.

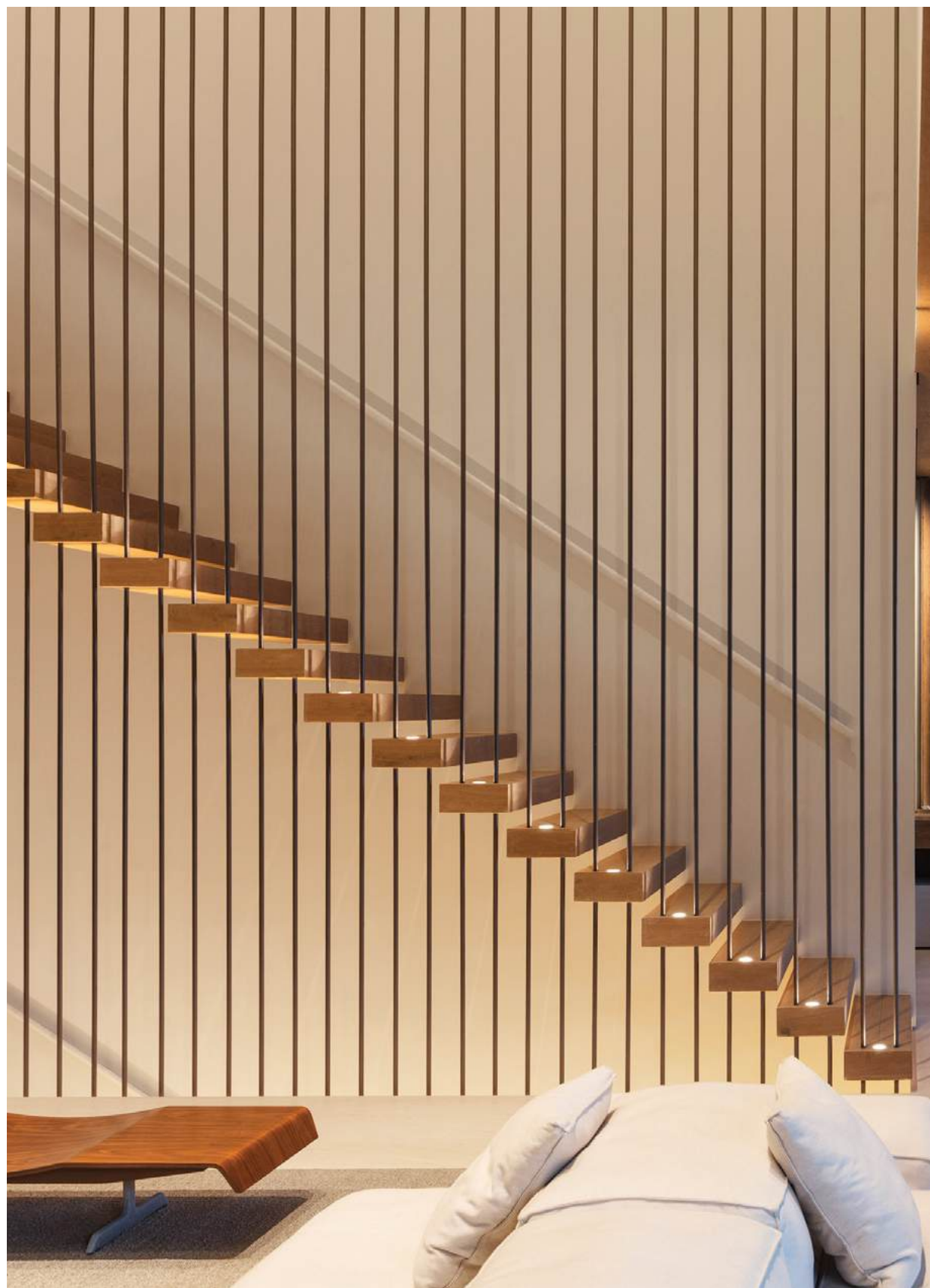






STAIRS & ACCESSORIES
