Wood species & grades

European oak and ash

Hakwood sources the finest varieties of oak and ash, using local, naturally sustainable species from European woodland within an area that spans from France to the Balkans.

The majority of Hakwood's products are made in European oak. Long-associated with projects designed to stand the test of time (architecture, shipbuilding, furniture), oak possesses all the necessary attributes for lasting quality: beyond its sheer beauty, it is resistant, stable and sustainable.

Hakwood also offers some products in European ash, whose qualities are comparable to those of oak and thus meet the same stringent requirements.

Choosing between these two species essentially comes down to a question of taste. The warm tones and familiar character of oak, or the finer, paler grain of ash. While it is generally considered that oak is the more solid of the two, oak and ash are both extremely resilient to the wear and tear of intensive use.

In order to ensure the premium quality of its products, Hakwood only uses wood from trees that have reached maturity, typically some 100 to 200 years old. Hardwood is selected from the lower part of the tree, from the base and trunk, which provide the most uniform wood with no or few, light knots.



Selecting the right grade

Once the wood has rested sufficiently and achieved the optimum level of moisture content, it can begin its journey to become finished engineered flooring.

Our experts meticulously examine each lamella to assess its grade. With a vast selection of grades available, this step demands a trained eye and complete focus. For optimal results, both sides of the lamella are inspected and the best is selected as the finished face.

DuoPlank® enables the installation of Hakwood flooring in places and under conditions where solid flooring is not an option. Our planks are designed to reduce movement in your flooring, no matter the season.

Laminating the plywood & hardwood

For each grade, the lamellae move on to the next step: gluing. Using formaldehyde-free glue, we secure the lamellae to a water-resistant Baltic birch plywood backer. DuoPlank® is now a reality. As the inventor of DuoPlank®, we only use the finest quality Baltic birch plywood that has a perfectly balanced moisture content with our lamellae. The combination of our dried hardwood and birch plywood creates a base plank that is one of the most stable in the world.

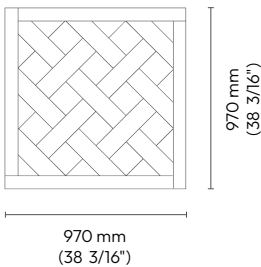
01 Alcazar

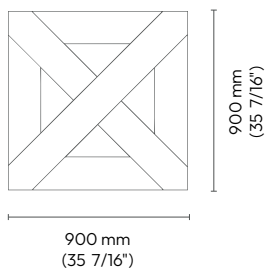
02 Versailles

Hakwood Complete Finish Care is a water-based care emulsion that forms a dirt-repellent protective film. It enhances the appearance of the surface, fills microscopic scratches, and helps extend the lifespan of the finish.

Application: For renewing the protective layer and reinforcing the finish of Hakwood floors.
